The fellowship includes a \$500 stipend, an expenses-paid trip (up to \$1000) to the annual RTDNA@NAB International Conference in Las Vegas, April 11-14, 2010, and a year's membership in RTDNA. Applications are due February 1, 2010. RTDNF will select the winner by March 15th and introduce that journalist at the RTDNA@NAB International Conference.

Applications for the fellowship must include: this form, a copy of your resume, DVD with one to three work samples showcasing your journalism skills (limited to 15 minutes total running time), a brief statement describing your role in the pieces submitted, a one-page statement explaining your interest in health and medical reporting, and a letter of recommendation from your news director or supervising editor.
